Area Facts

-The market has almost 3 million people within a 45-minute drive. There are 4 million pedestrian crossings and 12 million vehicular crossings annually between El Paso and Mexico. It stands as one of the busiest ports of entry along the border.

-2010 will be the 72nd Anniversary for the nationally famous televised Sun Bowl Parade. Over 500,000 people attend this event annually.

- Within 1 mile of Canutillo High School and El Paso Community College.

-Fort Bliss is one of the United States largest bases and home to the annual Amigo Air Show. The base is expected to gain over 27,000 families in the next year.

-Sunland Raceway is just minutes away from The Outlet Shoppes at El Paso. It is home to the annual Borderland Derby, a thoroughbred horse prep race for the Kentucky Derby.

-El Paso is the cultural center of the Southwest, enriched for more than four centuries by contributions from Native Americans, Spanish settlers, Europeans and Asians.
